

## **BIO-DATA DR KK BANSAL**

I have started my Medicine journey in 1986, when I got admission into medical school at Bikaner. I completed my MBBS in 93 and then MS general surgery I did from SMS medical College Jaipur. Then I joined SGPGI as MCh Resident in 1998 and completed Neurosurgery residency in 2000 December. Then I worked as a junior consultant at Indraprastha Hospital, New Delhi. From 2003, I went to Nagoya Japan as Sugita scholar. I have worked as a UICC fellow and brain tumour research fellow at Hospital for six children's at University of Toronto, Canada in 2005 and 2006. Then in 2003 itself, I joined as assistant PROF in Himalaya Institute of medical sciences, Dehradun.

Then gradually with promotion, I became Prof of Neurosurgery and Dept of General surgery in 2008 and I left the department in 2011 December. Then I joined Narayana Hospital Jaipur as senior consultant. Until now I am working at the same place as senior consultant, Neurosurgery Narayana health, Jaipur.

I have organised many national and international conferences and regional conferences over the last 20 years. In 2015, I organised the white matter fiber dissection course on cadavers first time in Southeast Asia. After that every year, I am organising 3-D Neurofest at Jaipur, which has been witnessed by and attended by hundreds of Neurosurgeons across the globe every year. In 2023, I organised the national neuroma society of India's conference at Jaipur, which was attended by more than 400 delegates across the globe. In August, this year we are doing micro vascular anastomosis course for the residents and junior colleagues.
